





PAVILION FOR DISABLED PERSONS

The residential building will be host to a community of about seven young disabled persons. Instead of following standard protocols used for building clinical institutions, the project was informed solely by a manual on "special residence" to help it comply with the needs of its future occupants. This helped create a comfortable environment for high-quality living. The circulation paths, coherence between spaces, relationship between inside and outside and filled and empty spaces were all taken into consideration for this pavilion-style patio house.
